

The open call for science communication projects

General aim:

- to support the activities that introduce science and technology and bring it closer to general public,
- to popularize science, scientific achievements and career in science and technology,
- to support activities that catch younger students' attention to science and technology,
- to promote the use of Estonian language in research.

The deadline of applications is March 9, 2017.

Previously funded projects can be viewed here (in Estonian).

The budget for 2017 call is €155,000. There are no upper or lower limits for the requested sum, but we intend to fund at least 15-20 projects.

Who can participate?

All private and legal persons who communicate science in Estonia can submit their applications.

Applications may be submitted in following categories:

- organizing public events, competitions and other activities that popularize science to general public;
- organizing science days, competitions, conferences, etc for students and undergraduates;
- audio-visual teaching materials;
- organizing exhibitions, purchasing and creating small-scale exhibits.

Applications do not have a set form but following information has to be presented:

1. The purpose and a detailed description of the planned action.
2. The schedule for planned activities in months (max duration 12 months).
3. Description of the target groups, communication plan (how the target group will be reached) and the potential impact on society (justification of the project).
4. The applicants' previous experience in science communication.
5. Overview of previous activities (if applying for development or repetition of previously funded project(s)).
6. The budget (as detailed as possible) where all other possible supporters and funding sources are mentioned.
7. The project manager's name, contact information (address, telephone, e-mail);
8. The applicant's name, contact information (address, telephone, e-mail);
account number;
name of the account holder;
name, digital-signature of a Authorized Person and date.
