Horizon 2020 is the new EU funding programme for research and innovation running from 2014 to 2020 with a €80 billion budget. The first calls for proposals for Horizon 2020 were published on 18 December 2013. Its simplified rules and submission and grant management tools should facilitate participants' tasks. For practical guidance, see the H2020 online manual.

H2020 supports SMEs with a new instrument that runs alongside venture funded research and innovation fields, so it should be easy for SMEs to find opportunities in many calls.

H2020 also aims to enhance EU international research cooperation so there are more opportunities for Third Country researchers.

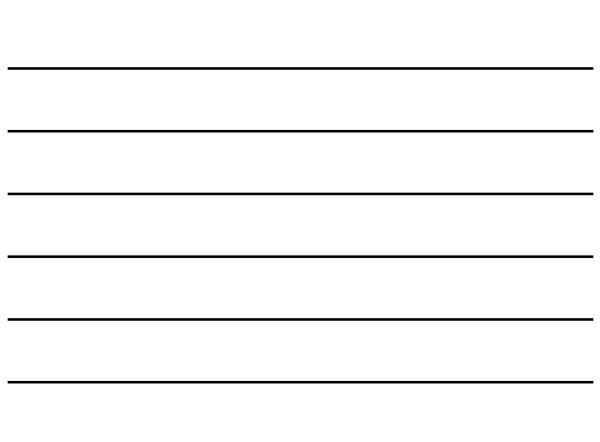
CSME

Programmes for the Competitiveness of Enterprises and SMEs (CSME) will run from 2014 to 2020, with a planned budget of €2.3bn. It will facilitate SME access to finance, create supportive environment for business creation, help small businesses operate outside their home countries and improve their access to markets.

Topic: Comparing the effectiveness of existing healthcare interventions in the elderly PHC-17-2014

Topic Description Topic Conditions & Documents Submission Service

Specific challenges: Effective health care for the rapidly growing elderly population in Europe is challenging and complex. This population is subject to frequent and numerous comorbidities, associated poly-pharmacy and frailty, cognitive and renal function, as well as problems linked to access to care and compliance. In addition, while the elderly are overrepresented in terms of patient numbers, this group is underrepresented or even excluded from many clinical trials that generate the evidence-base for health care interventions.

Scope: Proposals should compare the use of currently available (pharmacological as well as non-pharmacological) healthcare interventions in the elderly (> 65 year) population (or subgroups thereof). While there is no restriction on the diseases or interventions to be the focus of proposals, preference will be given to proposals focusing on interventions with high public health relevance, i.e. interventions addressing conditions that are particularly frequent, have a high negative impact on the quality of life of the individual and/or are associated with significant costs or where savings can be achieved.

Issues of particular relevance for the target populations, for example, poly-pharmacy, vaccine efficacy.

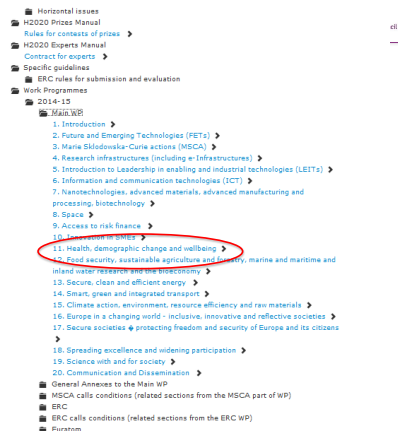
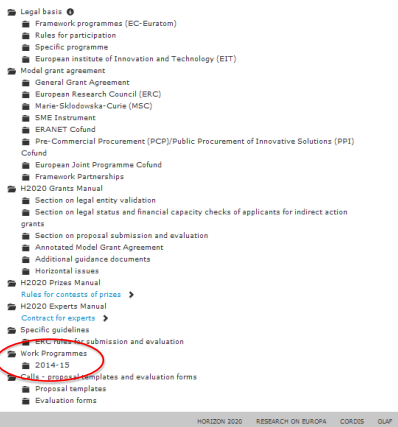

Step 1 - Find a suitable Call for Proposals H2020 ONLINE MANUAL

The Commission publishes on the Participant Portal all the Calls of its research and innovation programmes (H2020) and you can search calls from previous programmes (FP7 and CIP). In addition you can find information about some additional calls in the Other Funding Opportunities section. If you apply for the first time and do not know yet the programme, it is useful to read the H2020 Online Manual. It helps you choose the most suitable programme for your area and profile. Besides, you can search according to your research topic with key words and set filters in the calls list.

Your National Contact Point can also help you find the most suitable call for your profile. SMEs are in addition supported by the Enterprise Europe Network.
