- The implementing structure for COST activities
- Intergovernmental organisation with 36 COST Members + 1 Cooperating Member on board
- Established in September 2013 as an international not-forprofit organisation under Belgian law, location in Brussels
- COST Association organisation is composed of President, Vice-president, Committee of Senior Officials, Executive Board, Director and Administration
- COST organisation features the Ministerial Conferences, the COST National Coordinators and the Scientific Committee

- A building block of Europe's research world for more than 45 years - intergovernmental organisation - 37 member states
- Supporting networks that span scientific disciplines, countries, sectors and multiple stakeholders
- Largest framework for transnational coordination in science and technology, involving half a million scientists over this period



COST Actions

- A network of researchers, engineers and scholars with nationally funded research
- Collaborating in any S&T fields (bottom-up)
- of common interest to at least five COST Countries
- Submission to the COST Open Call for proposals
- Evaluated and selected via a tailored procedure
- Based on a 4 years joint work programme



COST Actions

- Open: expandable to new participants
- Implemented through networking activities: Meetings, Working Groups, Conferences, Workshops, Short Term Scientific Missions, Training Schools and Dissemination Activities
- Average Annual COST Budget EUR 120 000
- Pursuing the fulfilment of the objectives and deliverables described in the Memorandum of Understanding of the Action

- By contacting the Action Chair (Fast procedure)
- Support from COST: participation to meetings,
 STSM and training school
